AROMA

Ripe red berries and plums with a sweet earthy undertone.

PALATE

A rich, vibrant and full-bodied wine with complex flavours of red berries, chocolate and coffee. Very fine, dusty tannins, great length and persistence.

OVERVIEW

Blending the very best of the Barossa Valley, this GSM is sultry and seductive and has found a home in the Tempus Two Copper range. The Spanish claim Grenache as their own but you'll also catch the reflection of her French connection where she headlines the major Southern Rhone appellations including the acclaimed Chateauneuf-du-Pape wines. The grapes were machine-harvested in the cool of night after which they were cold-soaked, aiding in the extraction of vibrant colour and integrated tannins. The grapes were then fermented in open top fermenters and hand plunged three to four times a day.

Post-fermentation, the wine was allowed to mature in new American and French oak, allowing subtle integration of vanillin and spice characters, adding to the complexity of this rich, full-bodied wine.

CELLARING

This wine is drinking well now but can be cellared for the next 5-10 years.
