AROMA

Lifted aromas of ripe red berries and plums are complemented by a sweet earthy undertone.

PALATE

A rich, vibrant and medium to full bodied wine with complex flavours of red berries, chocolate and coffee. Very fine, dusty tannins complete the wine and provide great length and persistence.

OVERVIEW

Blending the very best of the Barossa Valley, this vibrant and flavoursome GSM is a blend typically found in Southern Rhone that includes the acclaimed Chateauneuf-du-Pape wines. The grapes were machine-harvested in the cool of night after which they were cold-soaked, aiding in the extraction of vibrant colour and integrated tannins. The grapes were then fermented in open top fermenters and hand plunged three to four times a day. Post-fermentation, the wine was allowed to mature in new American and French oak, allowing subtle

integration of vanillin and spice characters, adding to the complexity of this rich, full-bodied wine.

CELLARING

This wine is drinking well now but can be cellared for the next 5-10 years.
